The Tree Adventure™ surrounds all your senses and captivates you with fun and discovery. From the moment you enter the Woodland Pavilion, that includes a interactive indoor forest and movie theater, to a hike on the Exploratory Trail to the 50-foot tall Canopy Treehouse and Nature Club Cabin.

Arbor Day Farm is rich with history and committed to conservation. Owned and operated by the Arbor Day Foundation, this historic 260-acre working farm and forest is the model of environmental stewardship. The mission of the Farm is to inspire people to plant, nurture and celebrate trees.

Facilitated Badge Workshops and Self Guided Scout Activities Available on Scout Day on a first-registered basis, up to 25 scouts per session. No additional cost on Scout Day. Scout Day activities free with paid Tree Adventure admission.

Badge Programs:

Scouts receive two hours with Webelos and Cub Scouts admission to Arbor Day Farm® Tree Adventure,™ supplies, tree seedling, trail mix, and apple cider.

Cost: \$12 per scout, tax inclusive. Merit Badges are not included in these packages. Leaders should purchase them from the council office. 10 scout minimum. Additional adults or children admitted at regular rates.

Chaperones: Two leaders admitted free of charge with group. Additional adults admitted at regular rates.

Requirement Work Available:

Tree Adventure Woodland Pavilion contains interactive exhibits covering topics from Tree Composition to Urban Forestry, Riparian Buffers, Tree Heroes and Tree Identification. This interactive museum can be used individually or with a group facilitator.

“Wood You Know” Game: (all ages) in the Nature Explore Cabin, a fun and active way to learn about different kinds of wood.

Tree Sleuth: (grades 4 & up) A fun and engaging activity in which scouts learn how to identify trees by their bark, shape, seeds/fruits, and leaves. A hike on the Tree House Trail then offers the opportunity to practice those skills in a beautiful, forest environment. The facilitator will discuss the trees usefulness to wildlife and humans. Additionally, the scouts will be focusing on the sights, sounds and scents of the forest.

Biomass Energy: (grades 2 & up) tour the world-class Lied Lodge to learn about its environmentally friendly construction features. View how Biomass can be transformed into fire and steam. Visit our tree plantation to learn how fast-growing trees are grown, cut and re-grown for energy. Explore Arbor Day Farm's Fuelwood Energy Plant Visitors Gallery to learn about other renewable energy sources.

Trees Inside and Out (grades 1-5) is a Project Learning Tree Activity in which students act out the parts of a tree and its importance in helping trees function.

Dendrochronology: the study of annual growth rings of trees.

Nature Scavenger Hunt - (grades 1-5) Use a Nature Scarf to guide your walk through the Tree House and Exploratory Trails to find specific nature items. This activity increases scout awareness of the diversity of wildlife with search items such as “find something in nature shaped like a star”; “where do swallowtail butterflies like to live.” Each scout is allowed to keep their Nature Scarf.

Discovery Ride:

Enrich your experience at the Tree Adventure with a Discovery Ride. The Discovery Ride is a one-hour guided scenic journey through historic orchards and forest. Cost: \$2.50 per child; \$3.50 adults.
